





**CITY BETWEEN TWO RIVERS**

**MYKOLAIV** is a city of regional significance, the administrative center of Mykolaiv Oblast, and the cultural, economic, and scientific center of the Southern Black Sea Region. The city is located on the Dniester River and its shores. It looks into the Black Sea, the third area.

**MYKOLAIV BELONGS TO A HISTORICAL NORTHERN BLACK SEA REGION. THE UPLAND AND THE STEPPE FERTILE RIVER BANKS ARE ITS BACKS INTO THE BLACK SEA. THE THIRD AREA.**

**MYKOLAIV IS A MEMBER OF THE INTERNATIONAL BLACK SEA COUNCIL, A REGIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR FINANCIAL AND DEVELOPMENT TRADE AND INVESTMENT, SCIENTIFIC, TECHNOLOGICAL AND CULTURAL COOPERATION AMONG THE STATES OF THE BLACK SEA REGION COUNTRIES. ACCORDING TO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS MADE, MYKOLAIV'S PARTNER COUNTRIES ARE: BULGARIA (GEOGRAPHICALLY SINCE 1991), TURKEY (1991), GREECE (1991 SINCE 2011), TANZANIA (PEOPLES' REPUBLIC OF CHINA SINCE 2007), GAINI (MOLDOVA SINCE 2003), PLEVEN (BULGARIA SINCE 2005), ROMANIA (ROMANIA SINCE 2004), DUSHNOV (PEOPLES' REPUBLIC OF CHINA SINCE 2009), TIRASPOL (MOLDOVA SINCE 2011), KYNSE (ESTONIA SINCE 2012), ZHENGZHOU (PEOPLES' REPUBLIC OF CHINA SINCE 2016), WUHUA (PEOPLES' REPUBLIC OF CHINA SINCE 2018), BUDAK (BULGARIA SINCE 2022), HAMBURG (GERMANY SINCE 2022), CHEN (POLAND SINCE 2022), REIFFERS (GERMANY SINCE 2022).**

**THE KAM'YANETS'KIY BRIDGE** built in 1564 across the old floating bridge is known to be the oldest one in Ukraine that crosses horizontally about its pivot point 90 degrees.

The city has the longest pedestrian street in Ukraine called Shevchenko Street. It is a common meeting place enjoyed by all city people. It is a wide and straight street going down from the city's central square of the same name. Previously, the square was dominated by Admiralty Cathedral, the main functional cathedral of Mykolaiv.

**ACCORDING TO THE ALL-UKRAINE POPULATION CENSUS AT THE BEGINNING OF THE XXTH CENTURY THE TOTAL POPULATION OF MYKOLAIV WAS 588,100 PEOPLE, INCLUDING:**

316,000 - UKRAINIAN (52.7%),
117,500 RUSSIANS (20.1%),
4,200 BULGARIANS (0.8%),
3,900 BELARUSIANS (0.8%),
2,800 JEWS (0.5%),
1,700 MOLDOVANS (0.3%),
2,100 ARMENIANS (0.4%).

**ACCORDING TO THE MAIN DEPARTMENT OF STATISTICS ESTIMATION, THE TOTAL POPULATION OF MYKOLAIV WAS APPROXIMATELY 485,000 PEOPLE IN 2020.**
